The 150 bed hospital offers a variety of specialized services including 24/7 laboratory, pharmacy, blood storage unit, high dependency unit, 3 fully equipped operation theatre, a neonatal care unit and a dedicated labour room. We are dedicated to delivering advanced healthcare in resource limited settings.


Our College of Nursing continues to run its BSc Nursing program with a team of skilled faculty offering theoretical as well as hands on training. Besides regular classes, there is rotational posting at the JSS hospital in Village Ganiyari. Community outreach centres in other villages, as well as public health facilities. This helps to develop a broader understanding of the healthcare need, challenges and sensibility required in offering care, especially to the population we serve who have been historically marginalized.



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BSc Nursing has a 4 year teaching program. The annual fee for at JSS for B.Sc. Nursing is Rs 92,000 (inclusive of tuition fee, food, lodging, uniform etc.). **JSS will sponsor 50% of the annual fee for the four years for candidates who will agree to serve the organization for 2 years after finishing the 4 years of B.Sc. Nursing training program.**

Few motivated and meritorious candidates will be offered 100% scholarship, provided they are willing to gain experience and serve in the organization for 4 years after completion of the course.
